Build a castle. You could use boxes, Lego or anything you can find around the house.

Look after a plant, what does it need to help it grow? Draw or take a picture of your plant as it grows.

In the story, the giant had very big feet. Measure everyone's feet in your family. Who has the biggest feet and who has the smallest?

Draw a picture of your favourite character from the story. Can you add some labels to your picture?

Make a beanstalk using natural resources outside. You could use sticks and leaves found of the ground.

Create an obstacle course and imagine you are Jack on his Journey.
