Below are timings for daily activities/tasks as well as the specific learning for the day.

Suggested learning for the morning:

English –WALT: Write about personal experiences of our school

Can you draw pictures and write about your experiences? Can you read your writing back to somebody at home? (up to 40 minutes)

<u>Mathematics</u> – WALT: Solve addition and subtraction word problems. (Up to 50 minutes)

<u>Vipers</u> – WALT: Retrieve & Sequence: What did Fred see on the floor in the living room? What happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story? (15 minutes)
