Suggested learning for the morning:

Topic (up to 30 mins) WALT Use drawing to represent ideas	Have a go at drawing a T-rex by following the video on YouTube.
PE/ Active task (up to 45 mins) WALT Develop the overall body strength, co-ordination, balance	Join in with cosmic kids- Tiny the dinosaur.
PSHE (up to 30 mins) WALT talk about what is safe to go into our bodies	Teacher VIDEO 3
2.50pm Daily story time	A dinosaur called Tiny Teacher VIDEO 4
