

Please see below today's home learning tasks for World Book Day. In each box you will find the subject area, suggested time, learning objective and task. Some activities also have a teaching video link. On the next page you will also find instructions on how to take part in Reception's reading challenge.

Don't forget to dress up as your favourite story character and share your pictures on Tapestry!

English (20 mins)

WALT: Listen and talk about a story.

- Watch the video of Blown Away by Rob Biddulph.

- Talk about your favourite part and why. Can you draw a picture or write a sentence about that part?

English (30 mins)

WALT: retell a story

Teacher video 1:

- Make a story map – draw pictures of each part of the story or use toys and make map.
- Retell the story using your map. Use words like first, next, later, then and finally.

Phonics (15 mins)

WALT: Blend sounds into words

Teacher video 3:

- Can you blend the following words from the story?
 - Wind, flight, train, tree, boat.
- Which sounds can you spot?
- Can you add sound buttons?

Maths (45 mins)

WALT: explore and name shapes

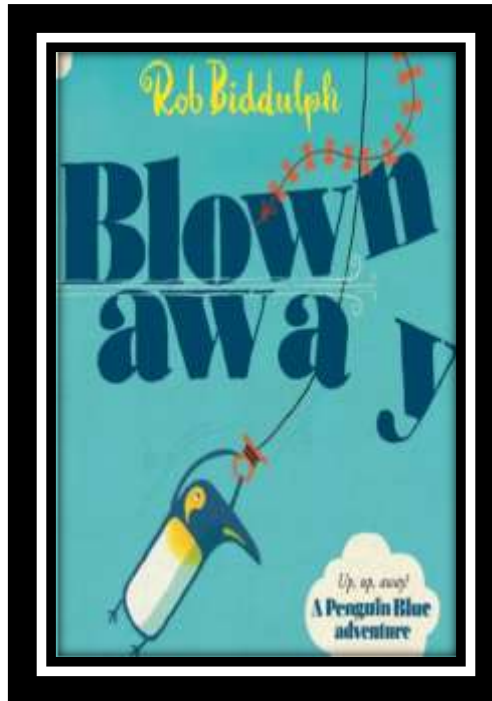
Teacher video 2:

- Watch the story again, what shapes can you spot in the story?
- Using only regular 2d shapes can you make a picture of the penguin and kite from the story?
- Can you name and describe the shapes you have used?

Topic (20 mins)

WALT: make observations about the natural world

- Find out about the places in the book – polar and jungle. You could use books or the internet to research what animals live in these regions.



Creative (15 mins)

WALT: draw with increased control

- Follow video to draw Penguin Blue.

WALT: experiment with different tools and materials.
