Below are timings for daily activities/tasks as well as the specific learning for the day.

Suggested learning for the morning:

English – WALT: use capital letter and full stops correctly. (up to 40 minutes)

Maths – WALT: compare number equations. (up to 50 minutes)

Suggested learning for the afternoon:

Geography – WALT: use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features (45 minutes)

PSHE - WALT: Suggest and use strategies for helping someone who is feeling left out. (up to 30 minutes)

PE/Active Task – Never smile at a crocodile dance routine (up to 45 minutes)

Screen Time Warning

While some tasks involve a device with a screen such as an iPad, computer, laptop, tablet, phone or TV, not all tasks will require such a device.

It is important that children do not spend too much time in front of a screen (learning or having some down time) and are enjoying other activities such as colouring, drawing, playing with toys, being active, reading and interacting with those at home.
