Priority 3: Develop Leaders at all levels

- To ensure that leaders at all levels have access to relevant CPD.
- To use the ACED Mastery Booklet for Quality Assurance processes across the school to ensure consistency of approach. ACED = A – Assessment, C – Creativity, E – E – Engagement, D – Differentiation.
- Leaders are given release time to impact on their subject area.

Priority 1: Ensure attainment is above the National average in Reading, Writing and Mathematics by the end of Year 2

- To develop reading systems even further in the school including 'We Love to Read', promotion of daily reading and the Class Reading Game.
- To evaluate the reading curriculum in the school including Big Cat scheme and the Reading Game.
- To create varied writing opportunities (linked to reading where appropriate) to excite and enthuse children.
- To evaluate online platforms for Mathematics both in class and for use at home.

Priority 4: High quality teaching and learning experiences

- To embed the new EYFS Curriculum.
- To ensure that all subject areas are driven by the BFIS Curriculum and shared regularly with all stakeholders.

Priority 2: Assessment

- To embed the whole school assessment timetable.
- To ensure interventions are accessed in a timely manner for maximum impact.
- To establish a new foundation assessment process which allows all subjects to identify pupils at risk of not reaching age related expectations.

Catch Up Curriculum: To support children to catch up lost time after school closure
