Join Chelmsford School PE Partnership & PLT Release Day – CPD (1 x term) and administration to develop the provision for a sustainable future.	<u>£1000</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase participation in sporting events and Level 2 competitions. • Increase access to active role models and memorable sporting experiences. • Provide staff with up to date and relevant training opportunities. • Provide Support to PLT / PE lead on how to maximise Sports premium funding and sporting opportunities for all.
Purchase new playground markings to increase active playtimes.	<u>£7000</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improve participation in activity during playtimes • Improve physical literacy and cognitive skills.
Attendance at sporting events (coaches fees and transport costs) e.g. Year 2 Mini Games.	<u>£1000</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Year 2 children can compete against other local schools in a range of athletic events in an athletic sports stadium (ensuring all have the opportunity to attend the event). • Selected children will be provided with the opportunity to attend a range of sporting events throughout the year.
To develop Quality Year 2 Sports Leaders to support lunchtime activities (staff training and pupil development) including coaches in the lunch hour.	<u>£8000</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will have the chance to develop their leadership skills. • Employ and fund a two play facilitators 1 attached to each year group. These members of staff will ensure that activity during playtime is maximised and introduce the children to different games.
Purchase of additional equipment to ensure all children are reaching maximum engagement in both lessons and during playtimes.	<u>£1500</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will be more engaged and participation levels will increase both during lessons and at lunch times.
Provide the children with sporting opportunities and in house enrichment days.	<u>£1500</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will have the opportunity to experience different sports, taught by coaches that are experts in their field.
Purchase new storage for sporting equipment.	<u>£4800</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoor Storage for Nurseries & Schools From TTS (tts-group.co.uk) • This will be located so that the children can easily access a range of equipment and therefore will increase participation in activities. • It will provide leadership opportunities – children to take ownership of the equipment.
Supply cover to release PE coordinator (6 days cover – 1 per half term)	<u>£1080</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subject release time to allow for subject development across the school and training

Primary PE and Sport Premium - Key Indicators

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.

There are 5 key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school

2. The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement

3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport

4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils

5. Increased participation in competitive sport
