

From Year One to Year Two

- The Year One team work closely with the Year Two team to ensure there is a smooth transition between the year groups.
- Assessments take place in the summer term and are passed on to the new Year Two team. These form the starting point for learning at the beginning of Year Two.
- The children will work towards taking their SATs assessments next May and will be regularly assessed against individual targets to ensure they are making good progress. There is a robust and continuous assessment process throughout Key Stage One so that teachers can quickly identify any gaps in learning.

- To provide a curriculum which is fun and engaging and provides opportunities to develop personal, social and emotional skills which will last a lifetime.





For outstanding behaviour a child will go on to gold.


Home learning

Reading-Year 2 5x a week
