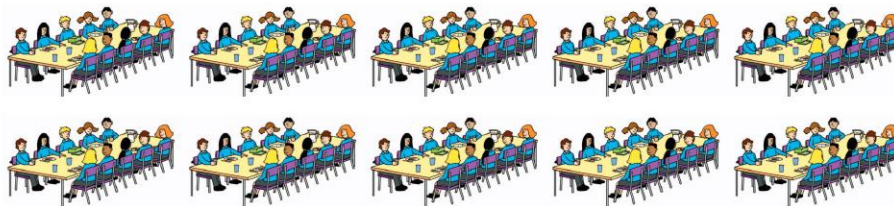
Challenge Activity Give reasons for why you like this character by using the co-ordinating conjunction 'because'.
