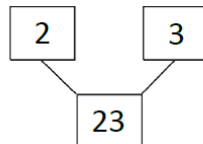
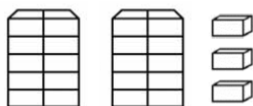
## WRITE TO IMPRESS DAY
