WALT – spot the rhyming words within a poem

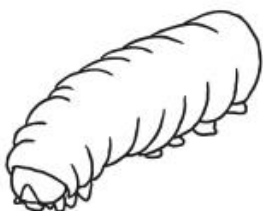

Write the rhyming words in your **purple book** and see if you can add 2 more words that rhyme with them e.g. not – hot, pot, cannot

Which may be the chosen spot.
No toad spy you,
Hovering bird of prey pass by you;

Phonics

WALT: 'hear' alternative pronunciations for the 'o' grapheme



This week we are learning alternative pronunciations for the 'o' grapheme. Read words: hot, spot, shock, clock, golf, so, don't, gold, both, hold.

(Play Acorn Adventures on Phonics Play to reinforce) Can you hear the different ways the 'o' sound is pronounced? Put them in a list based on their sound and write in **purple book**. Read - **Don't go to the hot spot. Can we both hold the gold block? Don't get a shock if it is too cold or too hot.** Write these sentences in your book.

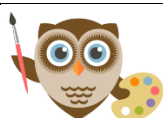
Active Task WALT – Use sending and receiving skills
