Maths - WALT compare numbers

Draw a number line to 100. Try to space each number out so there is equal spacing. The girl below used a bead string to make up her statement. Use your number line to compare two 2-digit numbers and use the girl's language to compare.



82 is greater than 22. On the bead string, 82 is much further from one bead. 82 has eight tens, but 22 only has two tens.
