WALT – know alternative spellings for the /ai/ phoneme.

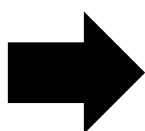
Log on to phonics play and head to phase 5. Warm up with Flashcards: Speed Trial, Flashcards: Time Challenge phase 5.

## Active Task



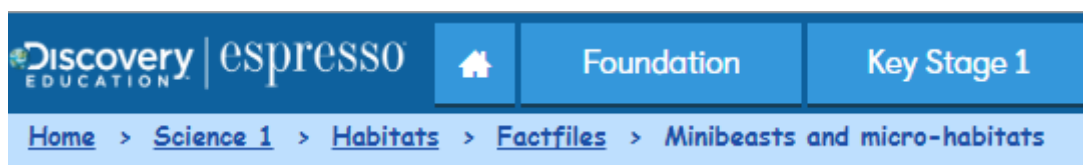
At 9am, get active with Joe Wicks on Youtube. 30 minutes of moving!
