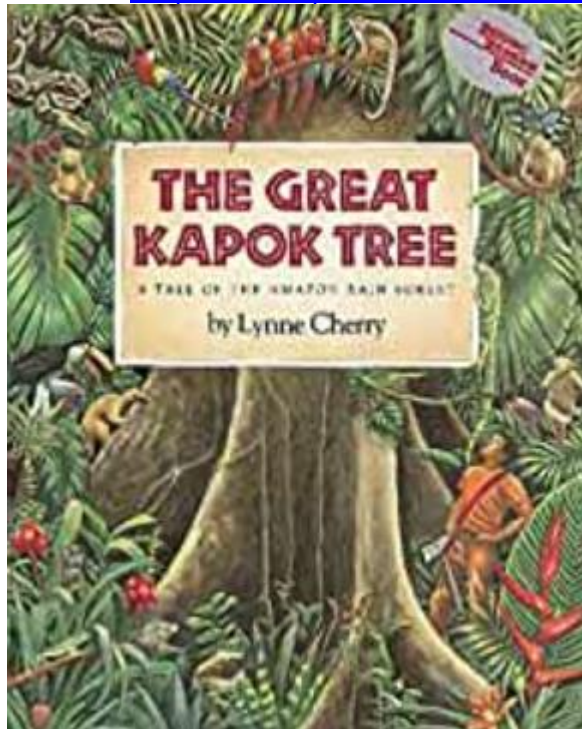

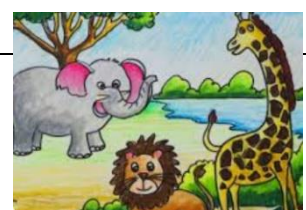

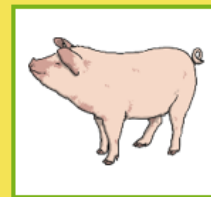
Topic Task (15 mins)
