'cool' and 'oo' as in 'book.' Make sure that you are with your child and saying the sounds for each word pointing out the different sound.

Use the phone and talk to someone that you haven't seen for a while. Talk to them about you Home Learning and ask them how they are feeling.






Today's Story (15 minutes)
