English – Writing (25 minutes)

Can you write some sentences in your diary today? Think about what you have been doing for the last week. What was your favourite thing? Can you use any adjectives to describe what it was? Try to use the word 'because' in your diary.

Don't forget to write the date and underline it with a ruler in your **purple book**.

Challenge Activity Say how you are feeling but use different words to describe the emotions. For example – don't use happy, use cheerful, glad, pleased or overjoyed. These words are called synonyms – words that have the same meaning!

Maths – WALT compare height and length. (25 minutes)



Star Words: height, length, shorter, shortest, taller, tallest, longer, longest.



Gather together 3 or more of your soft toys or action figures. Can you order them from the shortest to the tallest? Add a label. Tell your adult what you **notice** using the words shorter, shortest, taller and tallest to compare the toys to each other.

Now can you find three things in your home that are different lengths? Compare and order these using the words longer, longest, shorter and shortest.
