Mask making

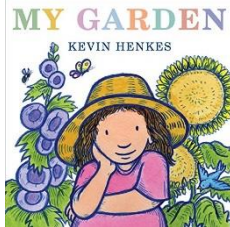
Use whatever craft or junk modelling resources you have, possibly even some leaves and twigs if you have any in the garden, to make a mask.
