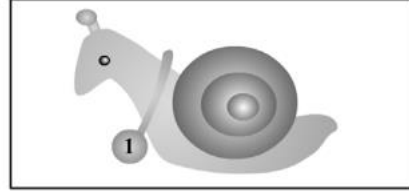
WALT find alternative spellings for the /ai/ phoneme.

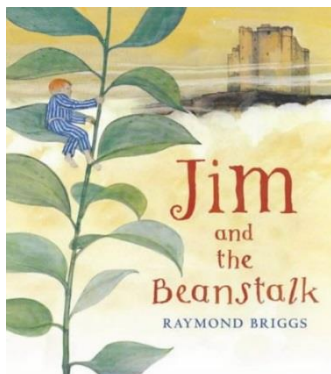


Act of Kindness Task
