Today is Elmer's Day, so we are going to create a celebration collage picture.

First we need to think about the background, if you have wax crayons you might choose to do a rubbing, or if you have paint you might try sponge printing, you could do both and then layer printing of stems/grass with a piece of cardboard on its thin edge to make tufts of grass. Or simply shade a background, maybe greens for grass and then think about a sky too.

Next, it is party time so you could add some bunting or balloons by cutting out small triangles, or circles/ovals, from a magazine or wrapping paper, or colour your own.

Finally arrange your elephants from the last few days, when you are happy with the positions of everything stick it down. Don't forget to post a picture of your masterpiece for us to see. :)
