Choose a book of your own and share it with someone in your house- why did you choose this book?



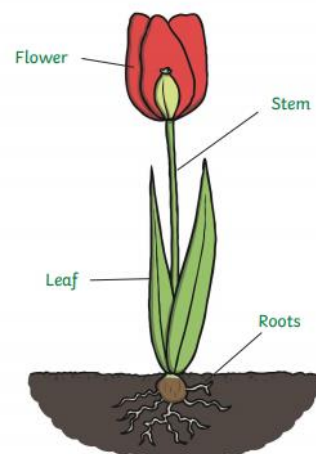
Topic Task -15 minutes

WALT: Identify the parts of a plant.

Draw a diagram of a flower or plant and then label the different parts.

Include: flower, leaf, stem, roots, seeds.

Challenge: can you write what each part of the plant is used for.
